REPORT ON FIGURES AND NEEDS IN THE CAMPS OF SHINGALIAN AND KOBANÊ PEOPLE

INFORMATION REGARDING PEOPLE MIGRATED FROM SHINGAL AND KOBANÊ

On 3rd August 2014, ISIS (Islamic State of Iraq and Syria) had started to attack to one of the most ancient and holy areas of Kurdish nation's, Sinjar (Sengal –Shingal) and its surroundings; massacring Êzidi Kurds, believers of the most ancient Kurdish religion.

ISIS has made an in tolerable massacre against Ezidi people and occupied whole of the region. Following these attacks more than 50,000 Êzidi Kurds have sheltered in the Shingal (Sinjar) Mountains. More than 300,000 women, children and elderly people have been targeted to forced displacement.

Since massacres and invasion realized in Shingal, the numbers of Shingalian people who crossed the Turkish borders from Habur, Yekmal and Roboski gates reached nearly 30.000 people.

However, since September 15, 2014, the ISIS attack on Canton of Kobanê that is going on in last two years systematically has increased incrementally. During that duration period approximately 200.000 civilians people who became targets of ISIS violent inhumane attacks and being under the massacre risk have been displaced and moved from Canton of Kobanê, passed the border and entered to the region over Suruc.

Movement of forced displacement population that has been accrued as a big tragically humanitarian catastrophe and crisis is occurring in Kurdish region of Turkey. Thereupon, efforts have been done to cover nourishment, clothing, health, housing and etc basic urgent physical and social requirements of people by municipalities of the regions in despite of limited sources as a first step. However, difficulties for providing and coordinating needs of shelter, nutrition and health have begun to appear. A central coordination committee has formed in order to determine the requirements and carry out all services in a systematical coordinated way.

The central coordination committee formed from representatives of these institutions: Union of Southeastern Anatolia Regional Municipalities (GABB), Democratic People's Congress (DTK), Local Administration Commission of Democratic Regional Party (DBP), People's Democracy Party (HDP),

Democratic Free Woman Movement (DÖKH), European Ezidis Federation, Rojava Association and Chambers of Doctors Diyarbakir Unit.

Under the initiative of central coordination committee, via great cooperation, solidarity and contribution municipalities, trade associations, civil society organizations, civil movements and all public in the region contributions collective life areas have been established in Nusaybin, Mardin, Kızıltepe, Batman, Siirt, Viranşehir, Diyarbakır and Suruç and also in a lot of other settlements.

However, the continuity of attacks and growing migration wave in addition to the challenging winter conditions have raised the need to set up mid-term and long-term policies for people from Shingal and Kobanê. The central government hasn't show the required sensitivity on this issue, and established only 3 camps for 8.960 people from Shingal and Kobanê. And, the government hasn't developed any policies for the remaining war victims.

While our local administrations provide the needs of migrated people with the coordination in each city, our esteemed friends and organisations both inside and outside of the country have kept supporting us.

The figures and general needs of people came from Shingal and Rojava is stated below:

1-THE INFORMATION OF EZIDIS MIGRATED FROM SHINGAL

The figures of Ezidis migrated from Shingal and the common life areas in provincies conducted by our municipalities for the Ezidi refugees are as following:

*2.840 Ezidis stay in AFAD (Prime Ministry Disaster and Emergency Management Presidency) Camp in Mardin / Midyat. This camp is under the responsibility of central government. The number is not included in general figures of Mardin.

**With AFAD Camp, the total numbers of Ezidi refugees goes up to <u>20.603</u>. The figures are regularly updated.
